This is the entrance that i will see when i arrive at the Lockhouse Buliding. There may be people going through the same door as me or hanging in the lobby.



This is the front door of the Barber shop. This may be open or closed.



When i enter the Barbershop i will see two chairs and mirrors. This is where i will get my haircut. There is a chance that there may be other people in the Barbershop waiting or getting their hair cut and music may be playing.



This is the Barbers chair that i will be sitting in to get my haircut. The barber may need to raise the chair higher if i am small.



This is the Gown that i will be wearing when i get my haircut. This stops the hair getting on my clothes.

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This is some of the equipment that will be used to cut my hair. Clippers can be noisy especially around my ears. But they won't hurt me. The scissors are sharp but the barber will protect my head with his fingers when he cuts my hair. The neck brush is used to get the little hairs off my neck.



This is a water spray bottle that the barber will use to spray my hair wet so it's easier to cut.



This is the hairdryer that the barber will use to dry my hair. This can be very loud and sometimes feel hot. The barber shop may have other people getting their haircut and these might be being used while I get my haircut.
